SAFEGUARDS PROTOCOL IN THE CONTEXT OF COVID-19

1. Parents or guardians will be informed of the preventive measures implemented in the Cheleg 2021 program to reduce and control the risks associated with COVID-19.
2. On the eve of each Sunday of the *Cheleg* program, all participants and volunteers are required to complete the online screening questionnaire [Risk assessment of COVID-19](#).
3. Inside the buses, all passengers will be required to wear a face covering.
4. Two people per seat. The first row must remain free.
5. Chantecler Station Safety Measures
 - a. According to government regulations, the station is ready to welcome us for this 2020-2021 season.
 - b. Full capacity on the slopes.
 - c. Regular schedule for ski lifts, ski school and chalet hospitality.
 - d. All indoor spaces open according to government guidelines, the resort will be able to accept up to 250 people at the same time in the chalet.
 - e. Face coverings must be worn at all times indoors and outdoors.
 - f. The café-bistro and toilets are open according to safety and social distance instructions.
 - g. Outdoors, the wearing of the neck cover for all skiers is mandatory.
 - i. It can be a neck mask, neck mask, hood or other tight-fitting clothing covering the nose and mouth.
